He also extended patronage to Muslim mosques and shrines, promoting religious harmony and inclusion.



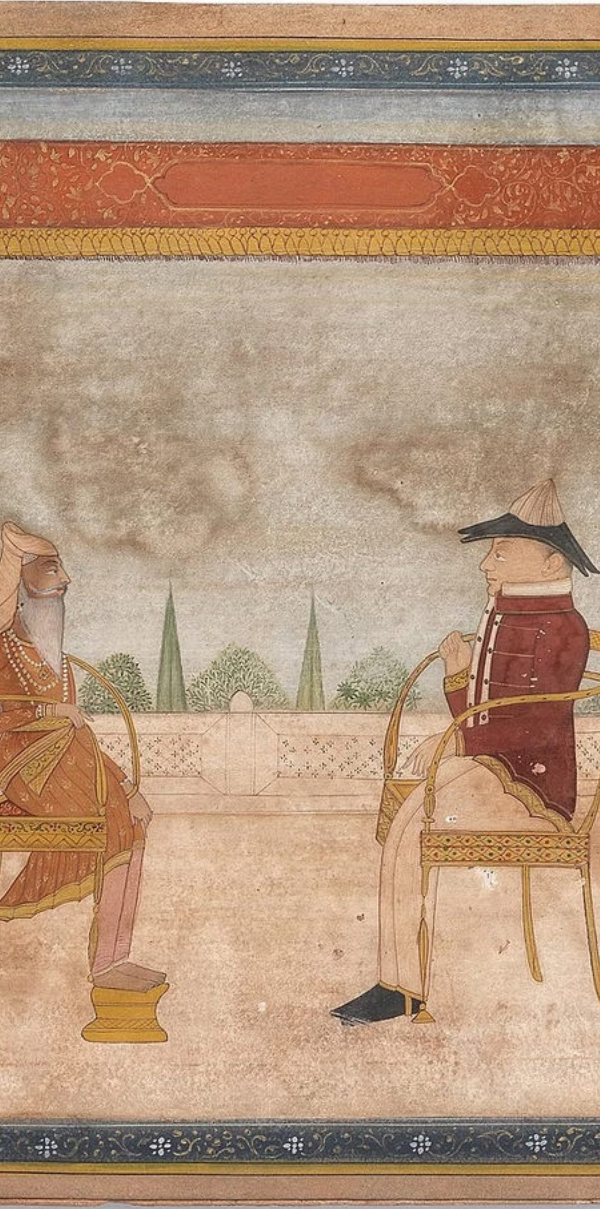
Sikh Gurdwaras
