


John Keats

- · Born on 31st October 1795
- One of the greatest English poets and key figure of the romantic movement
- · Best known for his works such as 'Ode on a Grecian Urn', 'La Belle Dame Sans Merci'.
- · He died at a young age of 25 due to tuberculosis.
- · His poems were indifferently received in his lifetime but his fame grew after his death.
- Epitome of young, beautiful, doomed poets.



Title

La Belle Dame Sans Merci (A beautiful lady without mercy) Keats took the title from a French poem. It means a beautiful lady without mercy. She is very beautiful and charming. She attracts knight with her beauty and charm. After that, she deserts him. She has deserted many other men in men in the past. She is a cruel and heartless lady. She is a temptress. The title is highly suggestive and appropriate.

Ballad

A ballad is a short story told in verse. This poem is a ballad. It tells us about false and unrequited love. It tells the story of a knight. He is entrapped by a beautiful lady. Then he is deserted. 
Introduction


