The punjab Reorganisation
Act was passed by the Indian
parliament of 18sep
1966, seprating territory from
the state of punjab.

PUNJAB UNDER THE STATE REORGANISATION ACT OF 1956

The larger state of punjab had been formed under the state reorganisation act,1956 by merging east punjab and pepsu.

WHY THE PUNJAB REORGANIZTION ACT OF 1966 WAS PASSED?

The 1966 sepration was the result of the punjabi suba movement, which agitated for the creation of a punjabispeaking state (the modern state of punjab)in the process a majority Hindi speaking state was created.

How and many states were formed under the Act of 1966?

- Under this act the new state of HARYANA was formed.
- Some territory of punjab was transferred to HIMACHAL PRADESH.
- CHANDIGARH, the capital of punjab was a made a temporary union territory to serve as the provisional capital of both PUNJAB and HARYANA
