Sketchbook

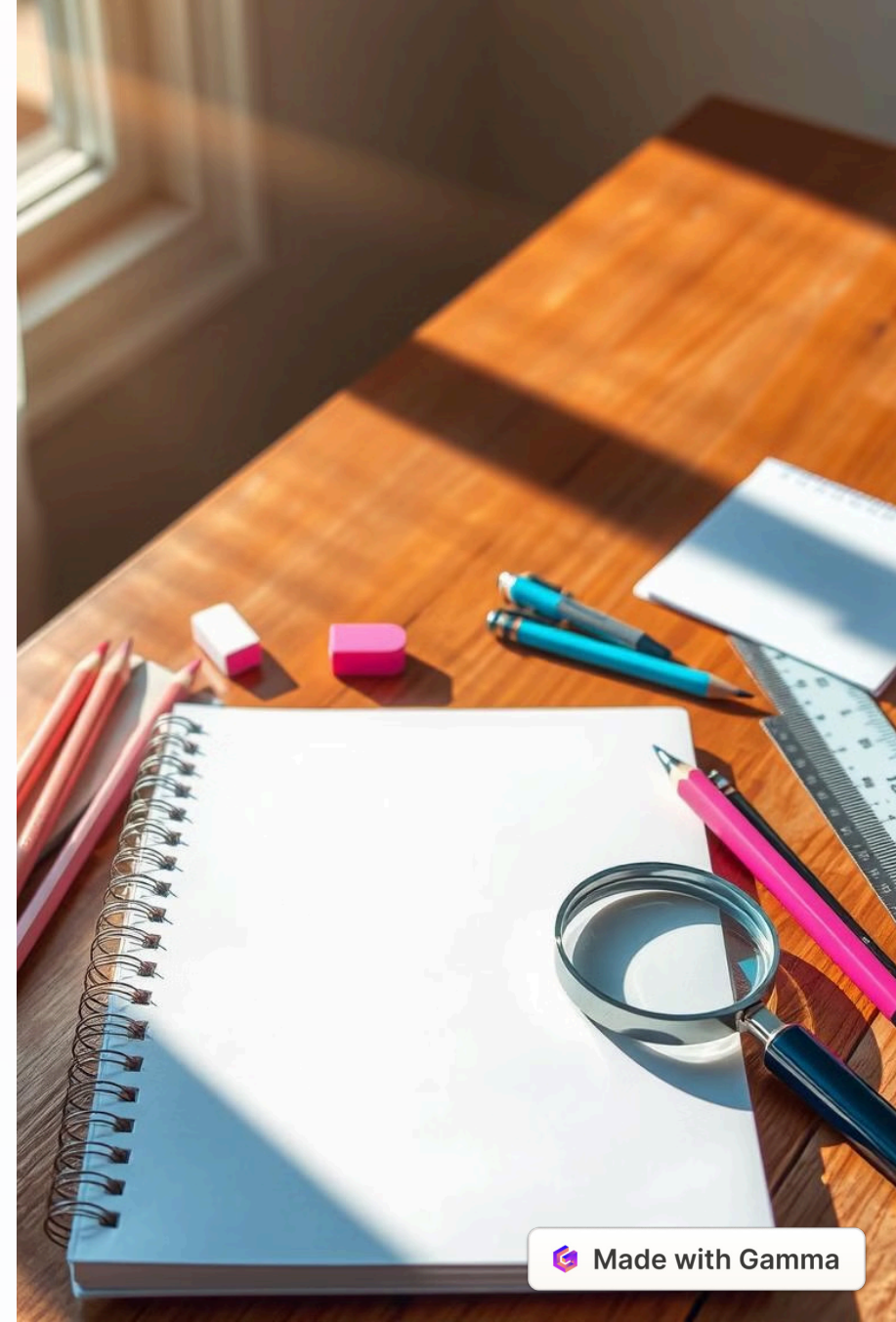
For capturing observations and creating the drawing.

Observe

Pay close attention to shapes, details, and textures.



Sketch

Create a rough outline of your chosen subject.

Measuring and Scaling the Sketch

Measure

Use a ruler to carefully measure the dimensions of your subject.

Scale

Choose a scale that will fit your drawing on the page.

3

Transfer

Use the scale to transfer the measurements to your sketchbook.

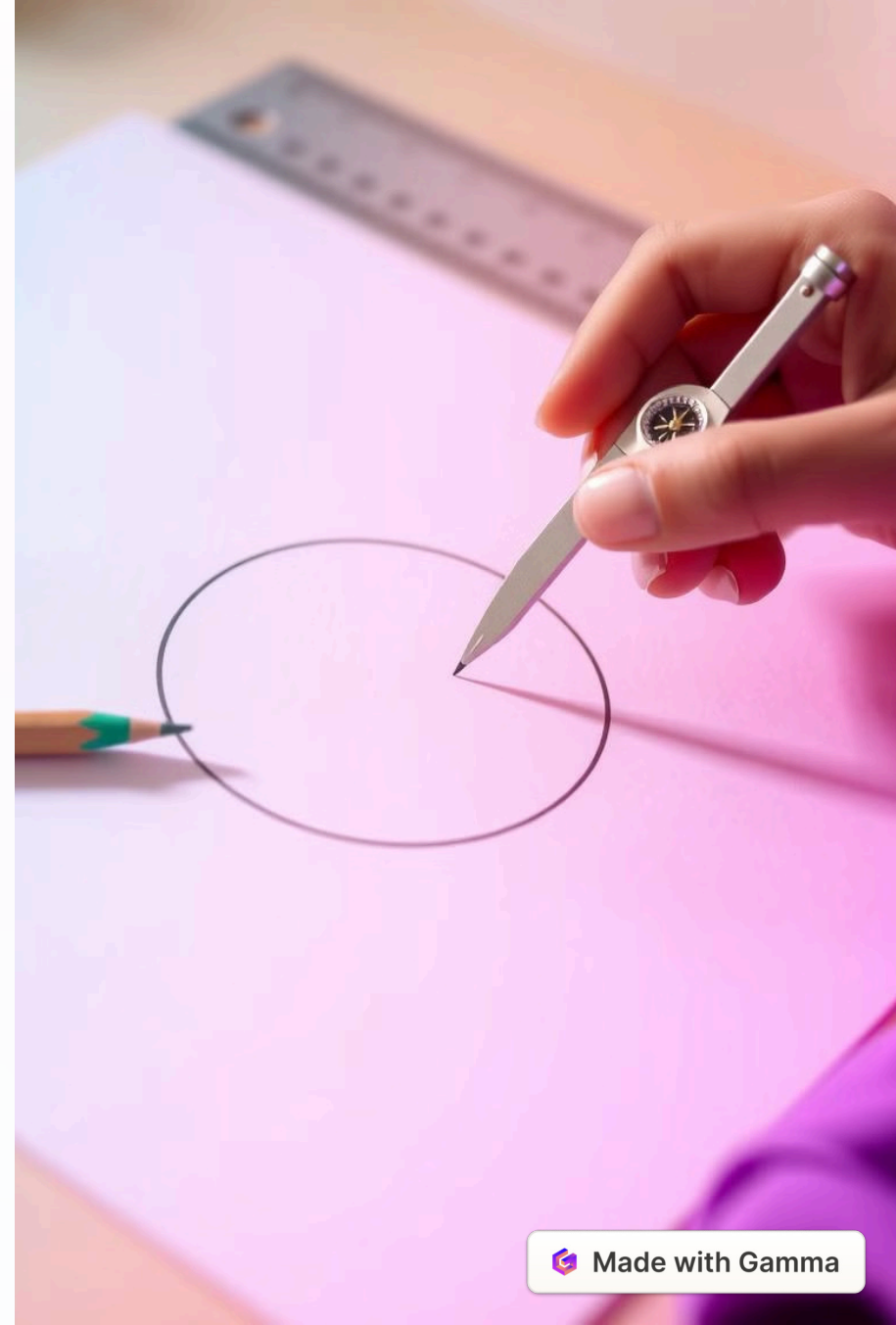
Transfer

Use a compass or ruler to transfer the scaled measurements.

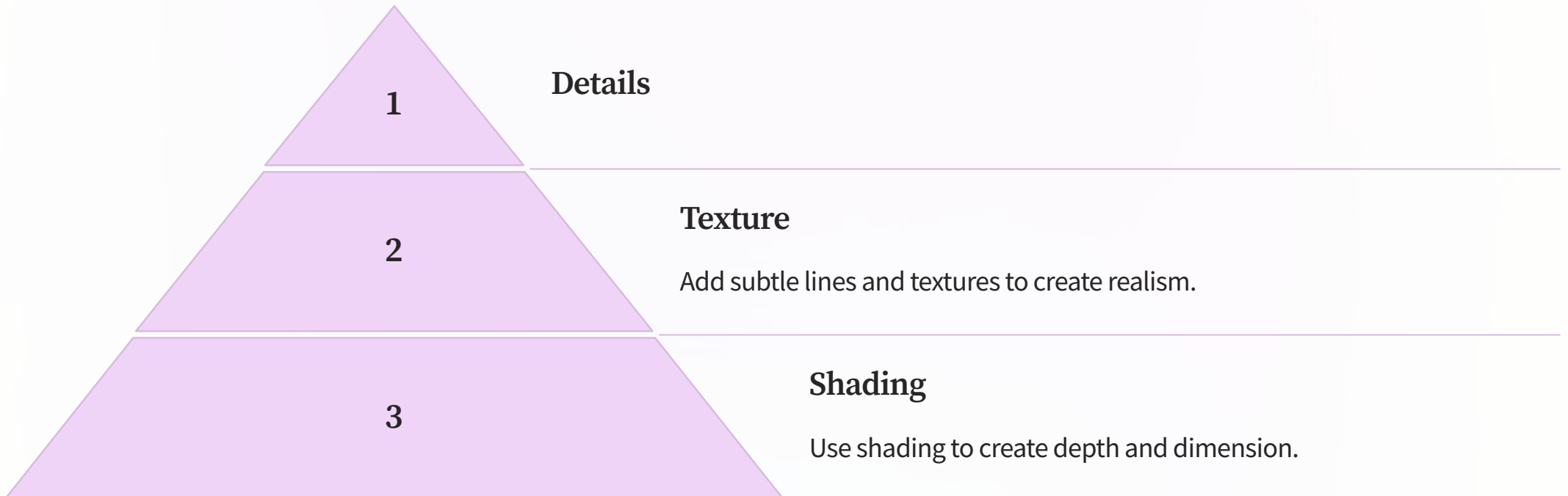
